Conditions of Contest

1. Yeh Cup Open Online Tournament

The Yeh Cup Open Online Tournament will be held on BBO from Friday 14th August to Sunday 16th August 2020.

Playing schedule pls refer to Appendix A.

2. Laws, Official Language, Scoring

The laws of Duplicate Bridge 2017 will be used,

The official language of the tournament is English.

Open Teams is scored by Victory Point (VP) during Qualifying stage and by IMP during Knock Out Stages (Quarter Final, Semi-final and Finals).7-board VP scale pls refer to Appendix C.

Open Pairs is scored by IMP both in Qualifying and Final Stages.

3. Entry Fees

Entrance fee is US\$50 per team. All the participants not advancing to Knock Out Semi-final are invited to participate in Open Pairs free of charge.

Refer to appendix B for list of players.

4. Line Up

In order to create the match in time, the line up for all teams should be provided before 8 pm on August 13,

Email the line-up information to TaiwanCBL@gmail.com

The team with the lower team No. is designated as the Home Team, and his opponent as the Visiting Team.

5. Create Team Match at BBO by Home Team

The Home Team is responsible to Create Team Match on BBO 10 minutes prior to the playing schedule for each round.

Home Team login BBO, select “Competitive”, select “Create Team Match”. (refer to Appendix D)

Mitchell movement with free seating is arranged by BBO system.

Boards Played: 20 Boards (10 rounds with 2 boards)

B-2 、 Open Pairs Final Stage

For the 20 pairs advanced to Final, pls made registration directly in BBO to participate the Open Pairs finals before 15:00 Sunday 16th August. The match id is “Yeh Cup Open Pairs Final”. Pls register it by inviting your partner to join.

Mitchell movement with free seating is arranged by BBO system.

C · Tie Breaking for Open Teams

C-1 · Qualification Stage

Ties on VP will be broken in the following order:

- a) higher IMP quotient in all matches played by the tying teams;
- b) if there is a two-way tie, the greater number of IMPs obtained in the match between the tying teams (should it have occurred);
- c) if there is a two-way tie, the great number of total points obtained in the match between the tying teams (should it have occurred);
- d) higher total point quotient in all matches played by the tying teams;
- e) Lucky draw.

C-2 · Knock Out Stage (QF, SF, Finals)

- a) The higher total points,
- b) The number of boards won (a different of 10 points is considered as a winning board, even though no IMPs are gained),
- c) Draw if the tie remains.

D · Rulings

Mr. Anthony Ching is nominated as the chief director,

During creating the match, home team should nominate Anthony (BBO ID: ching) as the Director.

An Introduction to Create Team Matches on BBO

BBO now supports team-games.

Any user with the latest version of the software (<http://www.bridgebase.com/latest>) can setup and run a team game. Scoring can be either IMPs or BAM (Board-a-match).

How does a team game work?

Eight players agree to play a team game. These players organize themselves into two teams, each containing four players.

One of the eight players, we'll call this person the **host** - creates a team game. A team game will start up one or two minutes after creation, and the 8 players are swept into their seats at game time. When the specified number of boards are played at each table, that table is closed. When both tables have closed, the match is scored.

Players can see the results in a few ways:

1. Enter the tourney, click TOURNAMENT RESULTS for a summary.
2. Enter the tourney, click MOVIE for a board by board listing with IMPs/MPs for each board
3. Use <http://www.bridgebase.com/myhands/> to see the "travellers"

Spectators are restricted to using Tournament Results and <http://www.bridgebase.com/myhands/>

Creating a team game

To create a team game, clicking the TOURNAMENTS button in the lobby, then click CREATE TEAM MATCH.

A screen will pop up. Only the 8 player names are required, but it is probably a good thing to enter the team names and match description as well.

You can select any reasonable number of boards - the minimum is 3.

The system will allow about 10 minutes per board. If time runs out while the match is still being played, the system will close the tables, assigning Averages

I suggest setting the director to the name of the person who is hosting the game and one person from the other team. You can specify two directors like this;

director1~director2 (notice the ~ separating the two names)

You cannot change a team game once you have created it. however you can close it and recreate it.

Closing, substituting, adjusting

Once the tourney has been created, you can enter it. When you do so, you will notice that the green TABLE button (to the left of the bottom toolbar) is lit up.

Click this to control the tourney. From here, you can delete the tournament, replace a player, or adjust a score.

Common problems

1. if a player gets stuck, or gets disconnected and does not return, press the director button. The director will be notified and can come investigate. If the director is playing, he won't be able to leave his seat. However, he can still substitute a player from his seat. If you setup two directors, one at each table, you'll be fine
2. Use chat-to-tourney to communicate with the other table if you only have one director
3. If all else fails, msg a support volunteer (a yellow player)
4. If you decide to abandon the tournament, please have a host or director close it on the way out

How to Register for Open Pairs in BBO

- 2 The top 10 pairs in both NS and EW direction will advance to Open Pairs Final.
- 3 Scoring is IMP. Play 20 boards in 10 rounds with Mitchell movement.

4 Qualifying Stage

Registration is made in BBO by 10:25 and seating is arranged by BBO randomly.
Registration will be open 10:00 or earlier.

Pls do it as early as possible. After 09:00, you cannot register.

- 4.4 Search for the tournament name as below:

- 4.5 Click this tournament

- 4.7 Pls wait patiently until 10:30. Upon starting, you will bring to the table.
- 4.8 **After finishing, pls keep an eye to see the final result.**
if you rank top 10 in either NS direction or EW direction, you will advance to Final.

5 Final Stage

Registration is made in BBO by 14:55 and seating is arranged by BBO randomly.
Registration will be open 14:30 or earlier.

Pls do it as early as possible. After 13:00, you cannot register.
